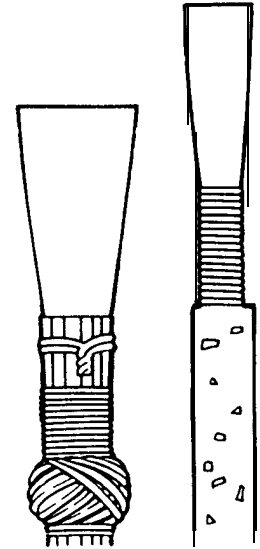
Grand City Tour
