No. 34: This polka features a triplet figure Eb-F-Eb. In the upper register, this combination must be played on the modern Lorée with the trill fingering made to favor the forked F in order that an equalized sonority might be maintained. Because of this, several Dbs will, by necessity, have to be played with the trill fingering, i.e. the so-called 'open' fingering.
